Highlighting Our Community Partners | Bremerton Foodline

At Bremerton Foodline (BFL), our mission is to reduce hunger and support self-sufficiency for individuals and families across Kitsap and North Mason Counties—but our impact goes far beyond food. Each week, we serve an average of 1,300 people through a grocery-style distribution model that empowers choice and dignity.

Recognizing that hunger takes many forms, we offer wraparound support, including home delivery for seniors, diapers and hygiene items, emergency meals for the unhoused, secure mail services for those experiencing housing instability, pet food assistance, and access to on-site medical and dental care through partners like Peninsula Community Health Services.

Additional collaborations provide case management, essential supplies, and moments of joy for families. As the region’s central food hub, BFL distributes over 2 million pounds of food annually to more than 20 partner agencies. Beyond meals, we connect clients with housing, employment, and health resources—because food security is just one part of helping our community thrive with dignity and equity.
