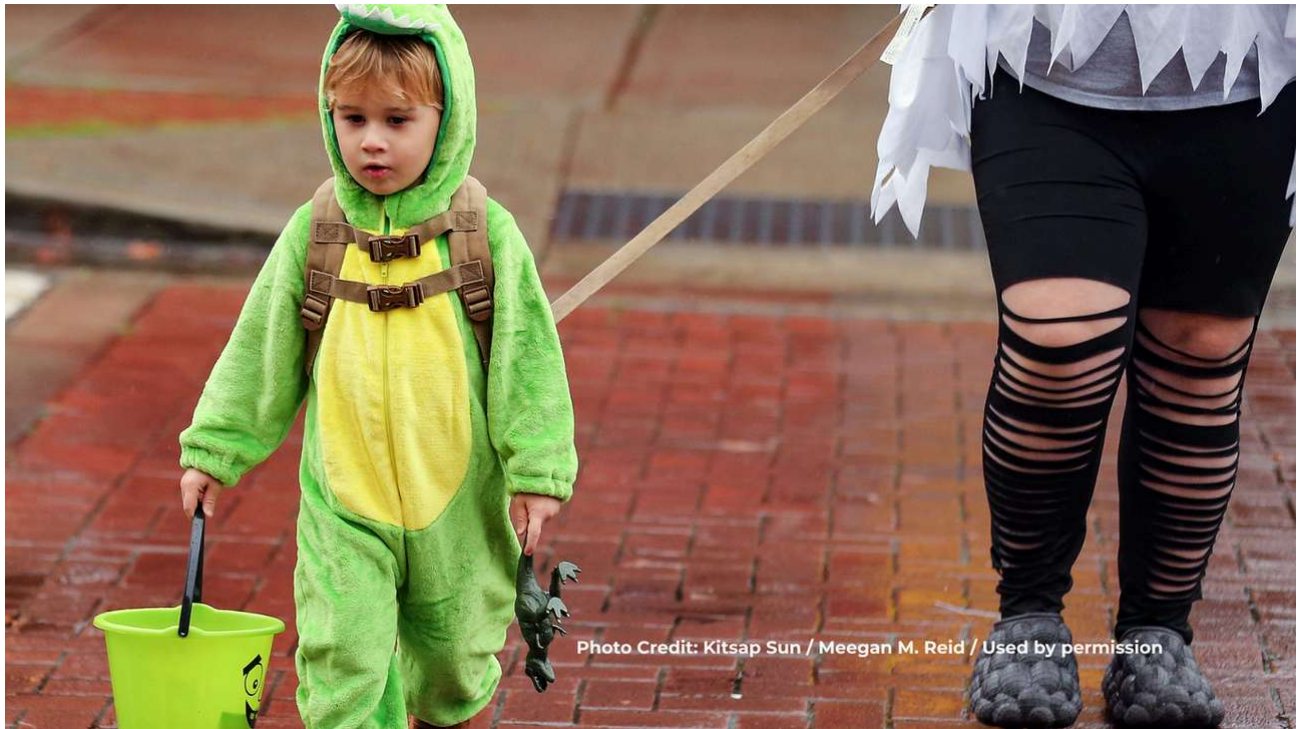

Trick-or-Treat Street is this month!

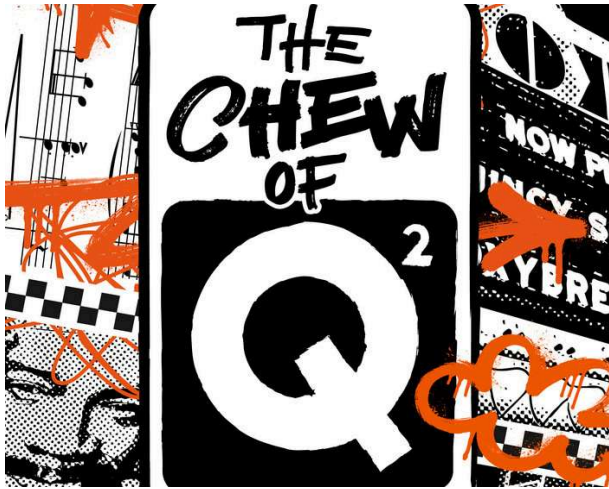
Friday, October 31st | Autumn is finally here and that means so is spooky season!

MONTHLY MEMBERSHIP MEETING

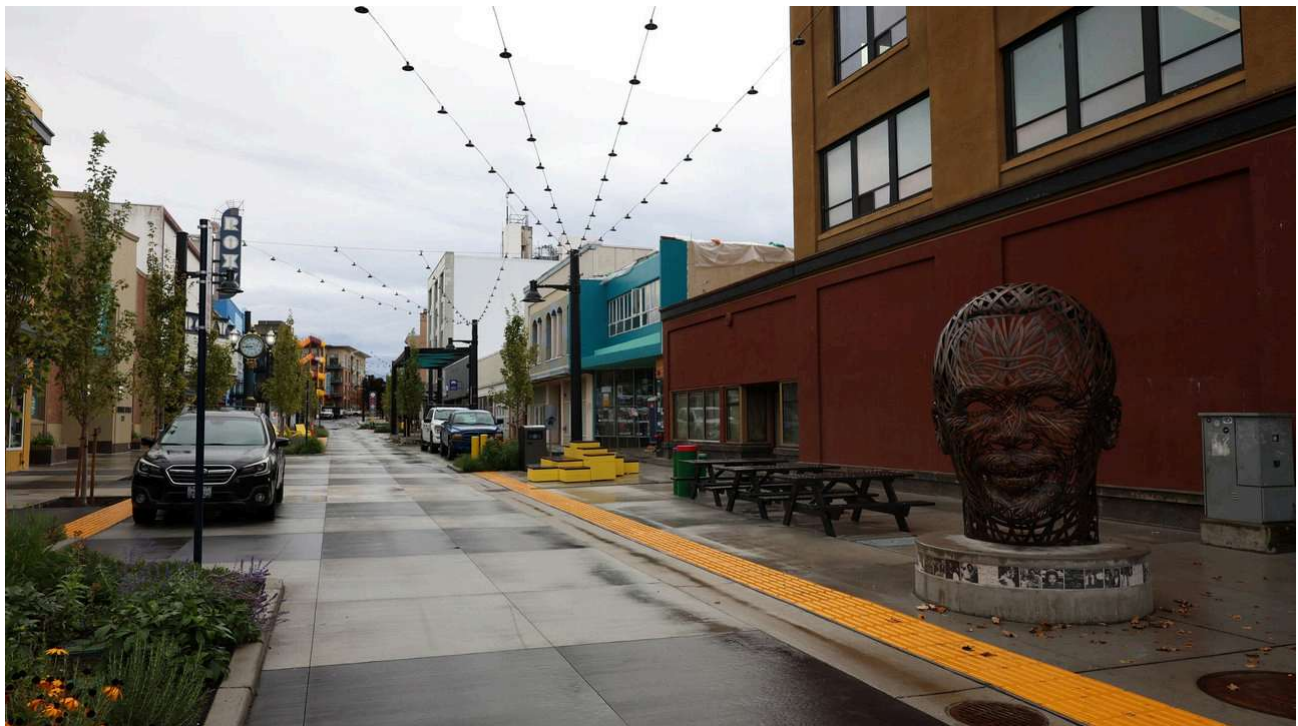

"Upon the request of the Downtown Bremerton Association, the City of Bremerton approved a 60-day temporary occupancy permit for "pop-up shops" to operate during the World Cup, which will play games in Seattle between early June and late July next summer."
