- **Interactive Music Installations:** Explore permanent music instruments installed along the street; designed to engage all ages.
- **Community Programming & Family-Friendly Activities:** Arts and crafts, and kids-zone.

This revitalized corridor reflects Bremerton's commitment to fostering inclusive public spaces, supporting the arts, and celebrating the community's diverse cultural heritage. It's not just a grand opening—it's the beginning of a new rhythm for Bremerton.
